FELINE ADOPTION CONTRACT



Thank you for your interest in adopting a rescue feline instead of supporting irresponsible breeders and pet shops.

The document must be completed in black ink and all pages of this contract must be initialled and the last page must be signed and dated. Once completed, please return the contract to **cattery@luckylucy.org**.

ADOPTION TERMS AND CONDITIONS							
1.	 In order to be considered for an adoption, you must: Be at least 18 years of age, Have the knowledge and consent of all other parties staying in the same household you want to adopt the cat/kitten to. Have the necessary consent of a landlord if you are renting. Be self-sufficient and have the financial means to support the animal in terms of feeding and medical expenses. 						
2.	Animals cannot be adopted as gifts for family members, friends or children. Parents will have to be primary care takers until such time as a child is able to responsibly care for the animal.						
3.	We will only consider the adoption of kittens and juveniles between the ages of 0 – 12 months to persons not older than 55 years of age. In the case of adopting a kitten and you don't have any other cats (under 7 years) we will only consider an application where two kittens will be homed together or an adult kitty on his/her own.						
4.	The Lucky Lucy Foundation reserve the right at any time during the adoption process to decline or cancel an application, without explanation.						
5.	All adoption applications are subject to a home check & adoption interview performed by a person appointed by the Lucky Lucy Foundation.						
6.	Please Note that you will be required to submit with your Adoption Application the permission letter from your Body Corporate to have a cat(s) in your unit should you stay in a Complex/Security Complex.						
7.	Disclaimer : Whilst every effort is made to ensure that all cats and kittens adopted out have tested negative for FEL-V and FIV we cannot be held responsible for the virus that is in the incubation period of 60 – 90 days. All cats that have been with us for longer than 90 days are retested to ensure their status.
